He earns his own way to Summer Camp!**

The Cape Fear Council is pleased to announce a new program called the "Camp Card". This initiative is designed to help Scouts earn their way to camp. Units participating in this program will **earn 50% commission** (\$2.50) on each \$5 Camp Card they sell. The cards will be distributed at February District Roundtables. The sale will end on May 10th giving units over 2 months to sell and close out their accounts. This program is **RISK FREE**, simply return any unsold cards.

The value of selling Camp Cards:

New Uniform - \$80 = 40 cards
New Tent - \$150 = 60 cards
Philmont - \$1,900 = 760 cards
Troop Trailer - \$5,000 = 2,000 cards
(40 Scouts each selling 50 cards)

Parent/Son - \$60 = 24 cards
Resident Camp - \$60 = 24 cards
Summer Camp - \$175 = 70 cards
2010 National Jamboree - \$1,500 =
480 cards

February, 2010	Camp Cards Distributed at Roundtables
February 26, 2010	Sale Begins
February 26 – May 7, 2010	"Fill It Up" Sales Form weekly drawings.
May 10, 2010	End of Sale – ALL ACCOUNTS CLOSED (Please call your District Executive to find out when money will be collected in your district)
May 11, 2010	Units closing out AFTER May 10, 2010 will earn 40% on their remaining Camp Card account.
