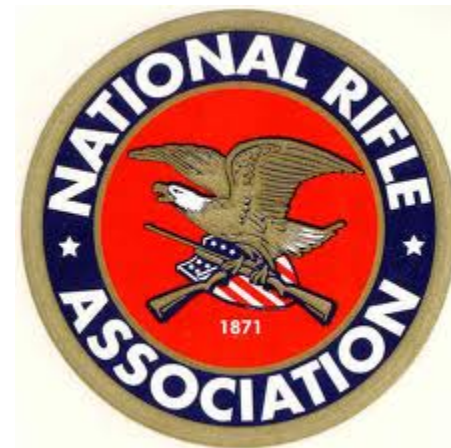

CERTIFICATIONS OFFERED

This training experience will consist of two weekends. During the first weekend, participants will be learning the principles behind basic instruction. Dining arrangements will be provided for you. The second weekend will involve a practical and written test that must be passed in order to receive certification.

The certifications offered are: NRA Rifle Instructor, NRA Shotgun Instructor, and NRA Range Safety Officer and Basic Instructor Training. These are the certifications required by the Guide to Safe Scouting to operate a Rifle or Shotgun range for Scouts.



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COURSE INFORMATION

This training will be conducted at Buccaneer Gun Club in Leland, NC. This course will be conducted over two weekends. Participants should understand that class will start at **7:00 AM on both January 28th and February 4th**. **Departure time each day will be approximately 6:00 PM.** **Attendance at both weekends for the entire scheduled time is mandatory.**
