

INTERNET RECHARTERING

This year the Cape Fear Council is offering Internet Rechartering to local Scout units. If your unit does not want to participate in Internet Rechartering please know that you are not required too. However, we do encourage unit leaders to consider participating in Internet Rechartering. There are volunteers and staff members ready to assist you if you need help with this process.

All unit recharterers that expire January 31, 2010 can access their unit's data from January 1st to February 28th for Internet Rechartering. In order to access your unit's data during this period your unit will need to email Beth Whitley at bwhitley@bsamail.org to receive an access code.

Once you get your access code you can begin your unit's Internet Rechartering process by visiting the following site:
