**Place: Boys and Girls Home - Lake Waccamaw, NC**

Cost: \$15.00 per Scout or Scouter, payment must be into Council by September 26.

Check-in: Registration will be at the parking area. **Units will be allowed to unload their vehicles near the campsite but are required to move them to the parking lot afterwards.** We can not have cars near the campsites.

Leadership: All units must be under the leadership of a registered Scouter over the age of 21 at all times. Each unit must insure that at least 2 adults are present with the unit while in the campground. Persons (Scouts and Scouters alike) leaving the camp ground at any time, other than at the end of the Camp-O-Ree, must inform one of the advisors. No burning or smoldering fires will be left unattended at any time.

Campsite: Menus should be planned so that meals may be prepared by patrols. The campsite and menu will be judged on quality, appropriateness for the climate, preparation and cleanliness, timeliness, and patrol cooperation.

Water: Leaders are advised that there is limited water available at the campground. The District will provide a water truck on site, however units should bring water with them.

Fires: If the ban is lifted in the county, we might be able to have fires. However at this time plan on **NO** fires.

Garbage: Please place your trash in the dump truck provided. Remember to leave your campsite better than you found it.

Latrines: Porta-Johns will be positioned at the campground. Please do not dig latrines.

Theme: 'Scouts vs. Nature' will be the theme of the Camp-O-Ree. All events will be based on basic Wilderness Survival skills. All events will be by patrol of eight or less Scouts. All Scout skill events will be drawn for The Boy Scout Handbook. Upon check in each Patrol will be given a score sheet and the station they will start at.

Awards: Points will be given for participation in the skill events. Additional points will be given for camp setup, roster and menu posting, menu and meal preparation, for patrol spirit and for campsite practices. Ribbons will be awarded to the 3 highest total scores for the Camp-O-Ree. Unit participation streamers will be presented to each participating unit.

Patch: A special patch has been designed for the Camp-O-Ree. The patch and awards will be presented on Saturday at the campfire. Extra patches, if available, may be purchased. Pre registration should help ensure that you receive your patch.
